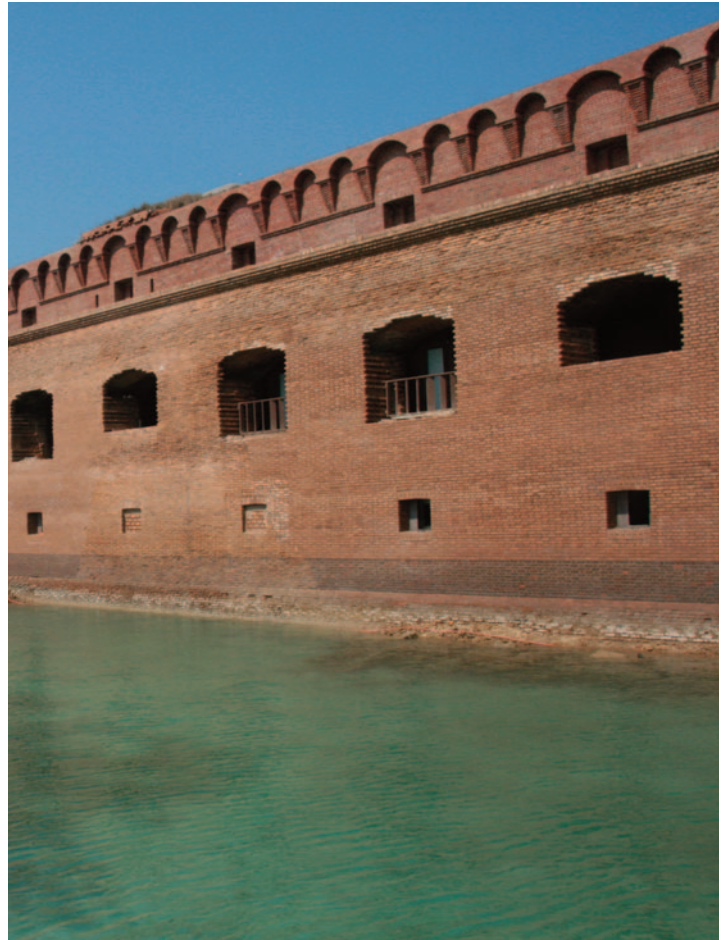

Repair brick masonry scarp wall; remove iron components of shutter assembly; partial reconstruction of shutter assembly; reconstruction of embrasure openings; repair and repoint scarp wall



PROJECT SUMMARY

Stone & Lime Historic Restoration Services was contracted for the following: repair the brick masonry scarp wall including masonry demolition; removal of iron components of the historic Totten shutter assembly; partial reconstruction of the shutter assembly using cast concrete replacement components, reconstruction of the embrasure openings; and repair and repointing of the scarp wall from approximately the magistral line to the top of the parapet.
